



Golf By-Law No.18 NOTICE OF SUBMISSION OF SCORECARD

Please be informed that, KGS Management Committee has decided to strictly enforce KGS Golf By-Law No. 18.

The KGS Management Committee at its meeting on Sunday 24th June 2018 has endorsed the following rules in addition to the said By-Law to take effect from 1st July 2018:-

- a) All official score cards must be submitted/returned within 48 hours irrespective of the number of holes completed;
- b) All official score cards must be signed by every member of the flight. A score card which is not signed by every member of the flight would be deemed as non-submission;
- c) Non submission of score card will result in Penalties under By-Law No. 21;
- d) In lieu of Disciplinary Committee being convened, the following disciplinary action would be taken in the event the score card is not submitted in compliance with By-Laws and rules (a) and (b) above:-
 - i) Non submission of the score card for the first 3 occasion would result in warning letter being issued to every member of the flight;
 - ii) Subsequent failure to submit score card will result in the handicap of the respective golfer being cut by 2 strokes on each and every occasion of non-submission of score card;
 - iii) If the offence is committed more than 6 times, the golfer would be referred to Disciplinary committee and suspended from golfing activities at KGS

GOLF BY-LAW NO. 2 NOTICE ON GOLF ETIQUETTE

Members/Guests are kindly reminded to strictly adhere to Kelab Golf Sarawak, Golf By-Law No.2 (Golf Etiquette) which requires golfers to observe the Rules of Golf and Golf Etiquette stipulated from time to time:

KGS Golf By-Law No. 2 stipulates the following:

- a) Safety
- b) Consideration for Other Players
- c) Pace of Play
- d) Holes In Bunkers
- e) Repair of Divots, Ball Marks and Damage by Shoe Spikes.
- f) Damage to Greens-Flagsticks, Bags, etc
- g) Golf Buggies / Trolleys
- h) Damage Through Practice Swings
- i) Golf Bags and Equipment
- j) Flight Leader

With effect of 1st July 2018, any breach of the above By-law will result in Disciplinary Action being taken against the offenders.
